
Conceptual Drawings:

The smart choice for conservatories & Orangeries

Whether you want a conservatory for a living room, garden room, breakfast room, playroom or even an office, you'll soon come to realise that it is truly a room for all seasons and you'll wonder how you ever went without it.

With a U-value of 1.0 W/m²K it helps minimise heat loss in the winter months, whilst a typical G-value of 20% means that 80% of the sun's heat is reflected back, helping to reduce heat build-up during the summer months. With visible light transmittance of around 27% your conservatory will feel open and airy, yet benefit from the anti-glare properties inherent in SMARTGLASS®.

U-Value Measures heat loss through the unit in winter months. The lower U-Value, the warmer in winter the room will be.



G-Value Shows the percentage of the sun's heat able to pass through the unit. A G-value of 20% means that 80% of the sun's heat is reflected back or absorbed by the glass, reducing heat build-up in the summer months



Light transmittance Percentage of visible light able to pass through the unit. The lower the light transmittance, the lower the glare within the room.



Self Clean coating reduces the requirement of manual cleaning, as it enables water to run off the glass taking most dirt and grime with it.




