Heritage sliding sash windows

Our Heritage sliding sash windows were designed to recreate the timeless elegance of timber windows but with all the benefits of a modern PVCu window.

Less costly than timber and without the annual maintenance that wood requires.

Sliding sash windows don't have to be draughty, high maintenance, cumbersome or hugely expensive.



The Heritage Slider comes in a range of classic and contemporary styles.

Available with the addition of Georgian or Astragal bars, run through sash horns, mechanical joints and a deep bottom rail as standard. This is perfect for period properties where it is necessary to maintain the traditional styling of the property.

They look equally at home on contemporary buildings that want to achieve that classic look.

We also offer bays and bows on a single cill, precoupled and with traditional bay posts.



Traditional Features

As close to the original timber version as possible



Run Through Horns. The run-through sash horns utilises mechanical joints rather than welded to allow the horn to be a continuous part of the sash giving the window a more authentic look.



Mechanical Joints. Mechanical joints take authenticity to another level. The 45 degree PVCu welds on the frame and sash are replaced with 90 degree mechanical joints as found on traditional timber windows.



Slide & Tilt. Both the top and bottom sashes can slide up and down for ventilation. An easy clean tilt facility allows you to clean your windows from inside.



Deep Bottom Rail. We want your sliding sash windows to look as close to the original timber version as possible. The larger bottom rail sash convincingly mimics the timber sash windows of old.

Planning & Conservation

We are often faced with projects that require special features to fit in with the unique character of a conservation area.





In the past, many planners used to refuse applications to replace timber sashes with a PVCu alternative. However, the Heritage sash window has been designed to recreate tradition, which has led to an increasing number of approvals granted.






Manufactured to a style to suit your home

Our windows come with equal sized top and bottom sashes (50/50 split) as standard, however we are able to manufacture other split ratios at your request (minimum transom drop of 350mm). 







Fully Personalise Your Timber Alternative Vertical Sliding Windows

Hardware

Our hardware is available in eight different finishes. Please note that our travel restrictors are only available in white, chrome, gold and satin chrome.

Satin



Lock. Our locking system holds the sash window shut by fastening the midrails together and is available in two styles.



Sash Knob. Used to open and tilt the sashes for easy cleaning of the outside frame and glass from inside your home.



Lift Hook. All our PVCu sliding sash windows come with one or two lift hooks as standard depending on window size. The lift hooks are usually fitted on the inside of the bottom sash to allow for easy opening.




Pole Eye. Primarily designed to be fitted to the top rail of the top sash. The pole eye enables use of a pole with hook (not supplied) to operate any windows that are positioned too high to operate by hand.



Travel Restrictor. The travel restrictors limit the opening of the top and bottom sashes to approximately 100mm.



D - Handle. Designed to be fitted to the underside of the top sash on the outside of the window to assist with the opening and closing of the window.

Advanced technology with traditional design






High performing modern materials and functionality with period character and design

Using a multi chamber sash we use the power of air as an insulator to stop heat escaping.

The 24mm glass, Argon gas filled double glazed sealed unit. It achieves an energy rating of A, with a U value of 1.4 W/m²k. The sash windows features wool pile strips that provide an excellent seal against weather, air and debris infiltration.

We have paid attention to every detail, our latest development is colour matching wool pile. This ensures that every single window is perfectly finished.
